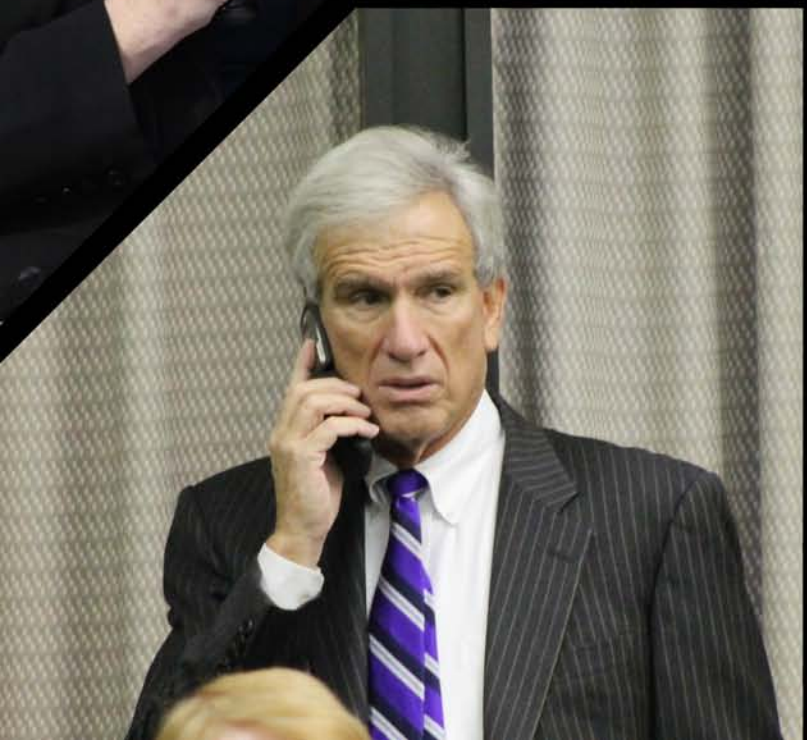

Purpose

According to most experts, on average only half of the eligible voters in the United States vote in any given election. One reason some citizens choose to not exercise this important freedom is a feeling of disenfranchisement because it is often difficult and time consuming to uncover the voting record of individual legislators.

The Family Foundation Action General Assembly Report Card is designed to disclose important legislator votes and present an opportunity for citizens to compare the voting records of their state legislators. With this quantitative analysis, citizens can make an informed decision when they go to the polls and be well prepared as they seek to work with and lobby elected officials. Covering a wide range of issues, this publication helps citizens hold representatives accountable, illustrating their worldview as it pertains to values-based issues.

The 2013 General Assembly Report Card is published by The Family Foundation Action. It is distributed for informational purposes only and is not intended to influence the outcome of any election. The Family Foundation Action does not advocate the election or defeat of any candidate and does not endorse any political party. The General Assembly Report Card is a cross section of votes taken on the principles of life, marriage, parental authority, constitutional government, and religious liberty. It does not include every vote taken on any one of these principles. The scores in the voting index are not to be taken as commentary on the personal faith or political philosophy of individual state legislators. The information in this Report Card is provided as a tool to help citizens more effectively influence members of the General Assembly on pro-family issues.

Criteria for Determining "Family-Friendly" Votes

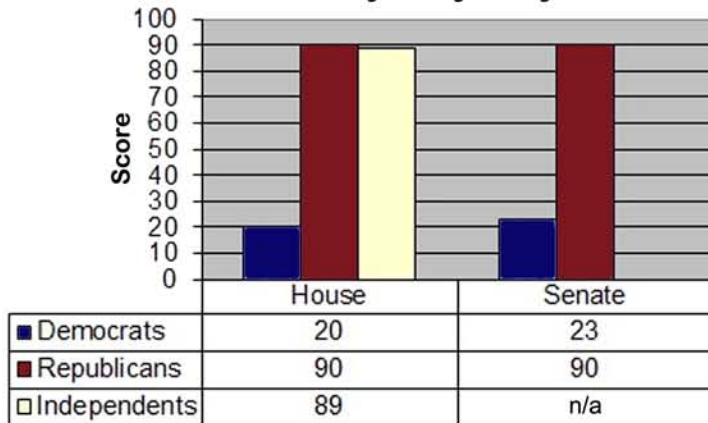
To be included in this document:

- *A bill must relate to the principles of life, marriage, parental authority, constitutional government, or religious liberty.
- *A bill must substantially benefit or harm the families in Virginia.
- *Wherever possible, the most recent or final vote on a piece of legislation is used.

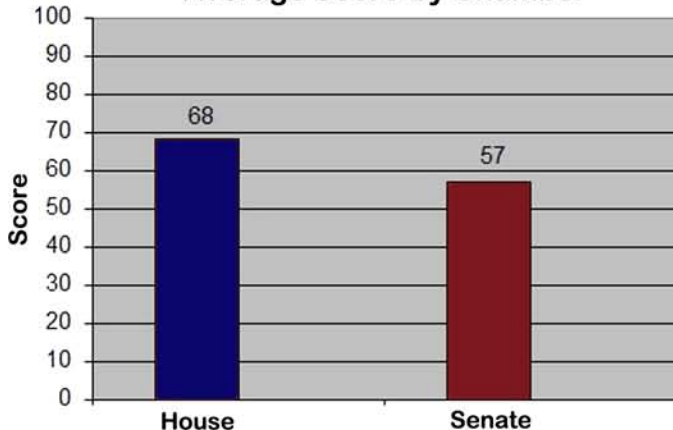
2013 Score Analysis

Score Analysis By Party Affiliation



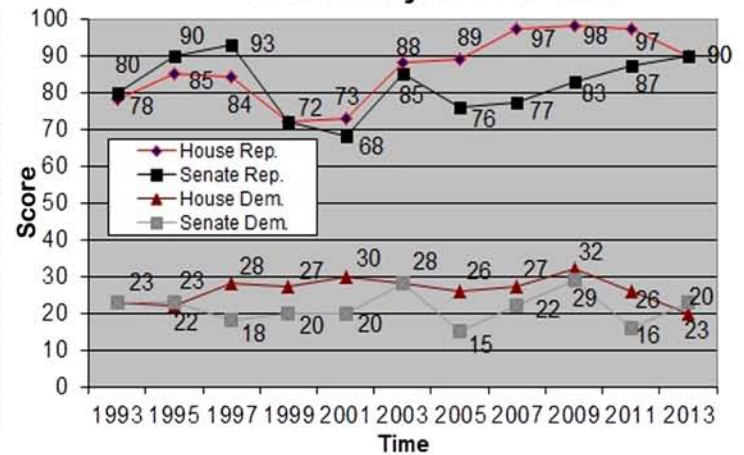
Average Score By Chamber



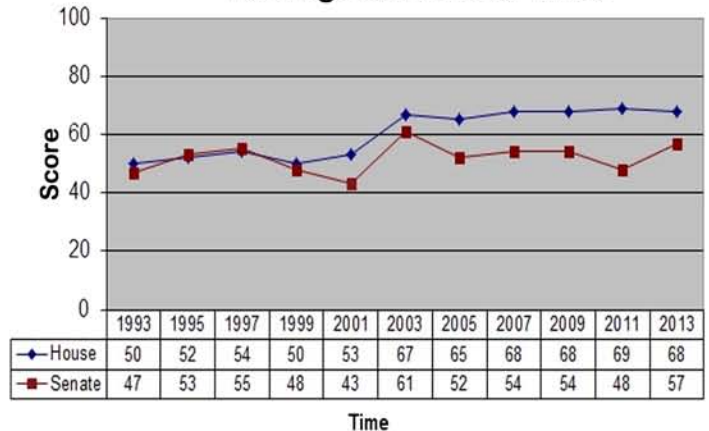
Score Analysis Over Time
