

SURVEY QUESTIONS

- 1 Require immediate reasonable medical attention to be given to any baby that survives a failed abortion attempt.
- 2 Prohibit biological males who self-identify as female from competing on girls' high school or collegiate athletic teams.
- 3 Prohibit minors from receiving hormone therapy or other medical procedures to identify as the opposite biological sex.
- 4 Establish Education Savings Accounts for families to use on K-12 private school tuition, tutoring, and/or school supplies.
- 5 Require parental permission before a child participates in Family Life Education (i.e., sex education).
- 6 Require written parental consent for any school counselor to speak to a student about sex, sexuality, or gender identity, and allow a parent to be present at the meeting.
- 7 Pass an amendment to Virginia's state constitution that would guarantee a right to an abortion.
- 8 Repeal the Parental Consent law that requires consent by a parent or legal guardian for a minor to obtain an abortion.
- 9 Legalize physician-assisted suicide.
- 10 Require all Virginia state employees to speak preferred gender pronouns to those who self-identify as a gender different from their biological sex.

All candidates were sent an issue survey. If a candidate chose not to complete the survey, voters are given that candidate's public statements whenever available and these responses are marked (A). Survey responses are marked (B). A candidate's voting record is marked (C) and is given highest priority. The platform of the candidate's party, when available, is marked (D).
