Purpose

With this analysis, citizens can make informed decisions at the polls and be well prepared working with and lobbying elected officials. Covering a wide range of issues, this publication helps citizens hold representatives accountable, illustrating their worldview as it pertains to values issues.

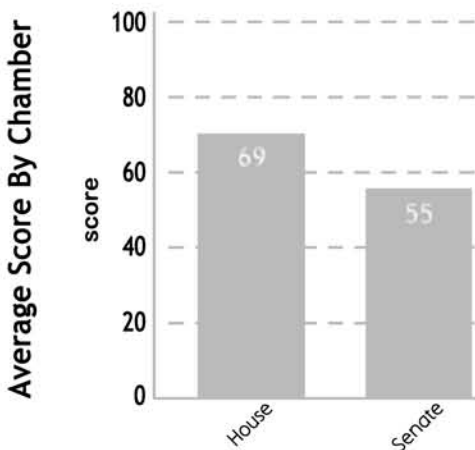
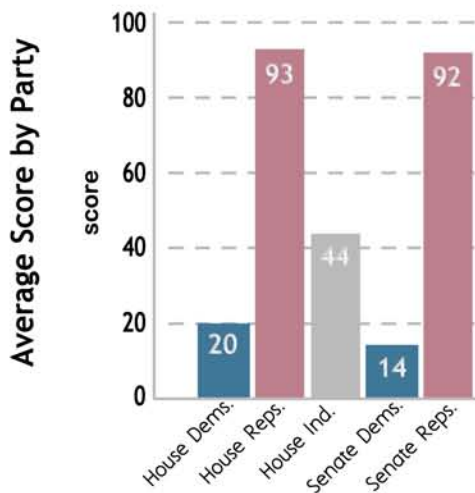
Criteria for Determining "Family-Friendly" Votes

- A bill must relate to the principles of life, marriage, parental authority, constitutional government, or religious liberty.
- A bill must substantially benefit or harm the families in Virginia.
- Wherever possible, the most recent or final vote on a piece of legislation is used.

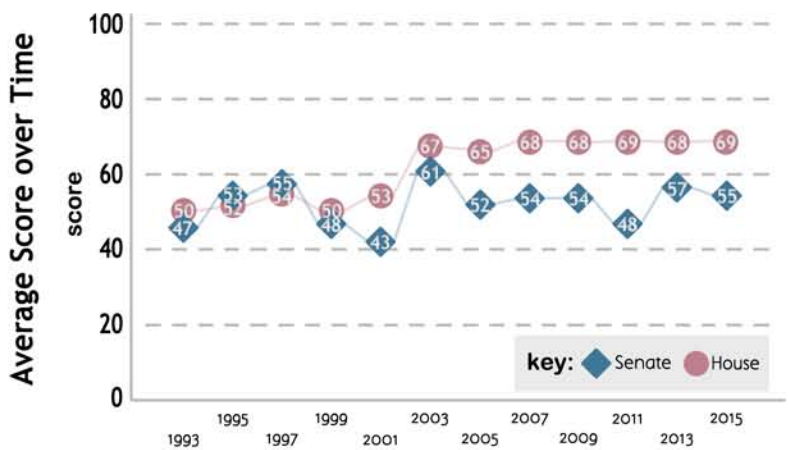
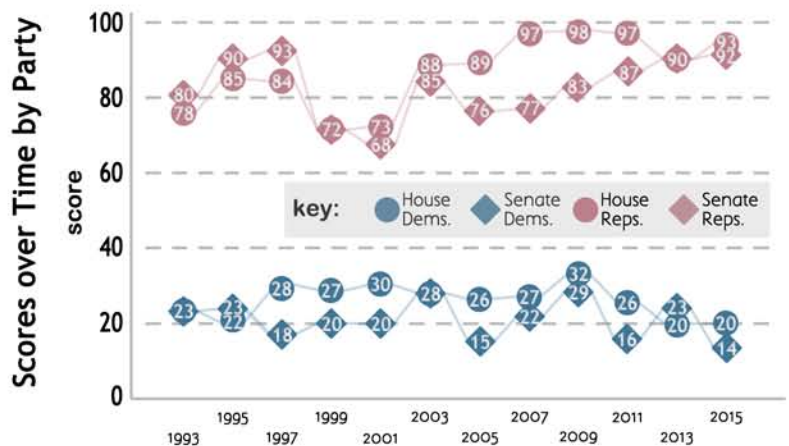
2015 Score Analysis
