# Hold Legislators Accountable To Virginia Values 



The precious freedom to vote is shared by very few people in our world. Yet in a nation that prides itself on free suffrage, less than half of those eligible to vote do so. Sadly, few citizens vote, feeling uninformed and disenfranchised because it is often difficult and time consuming to uncover the voting record of individual legislators.

This document is designed to disclose important legislator votes and present an opportunity for citizens to compare the voting records of their state legislators. With this quantitative analysis, citizens can make an informed decision when they go to the polls and be well prepared as they seek to work with and lobby elected officials. Covering a wide range of issues, this publication helps citizens hold representatives accountable while illustrating their worldview as it pertains to family issues.

The 2006-2007 General Assembly Report Card is published by The Family Foundation Action. This report card is distributed for informational purposes only and is not intended to influence the outcome of any election. The Family Foundation Action does not advocate the election or defeat of any candidate and does not endorse any political party. The scores in the voting index are not to be taken as commentary on the personal faith of individual state legislators.
The information in this report card is provided as a tool to help citizens more effectively educate members of the General Assembly on pro-family issues.

## Criteria for Determining "Family-iriendly" Votes

To be included in this document:

- A bill must relate to the principles of life, marriage, parental authority, constituional government, or religious liberty.
- A bill must substantially benefit or harm the families in Virginia.
- Wherever possible, the most recent or final vote on a piece of legislation is used.
- Wherever possible, votes taken by the chamber in which the bill was introduced are used.
